Other ways of getting here include driving from Christchurch, Nelson and the West Coast, travelling by scenic train from Christchurch, or getting a ferry to Picton from Wellington – with a vehicle if required.

Days of operation







Cancellations due to Government-imposed travel bans

Depending on intended travel season, differences in departure times or rates may apply as at the date of rebooking. Otherwise our standard cancellation policy applies.

About Marlborough

Marlborough is a geographical diverse region made up of the ancient drowned valleys of the Marlborough Sounds and the flat plains of our world famous wine region, surrounded on the fringes by hills and mountains.



Marlborough's location

Marlborough is centrally located in New Zealand at the top of the South Island. Marlborough Airport in Blenheim is a short flight from Auckland or Wellington – with a half-hour drive to Picton and Havelock. It is also a three-hour ferry ride from Wellington or you can drive from Nelson (1.5hrs) or Christchurch (4.5 hours).
